

#### What is the Project


- Reconstruction of Bay Settlement Road from just south of Bay Settlement Court to just north of Van Lanen Road
- Reconditioning of Van Lanen Road from the Green Bay City limits to Bay Settlement Road





## Bay Settlement Road

- Urbanization of the existing roadway
- No assessments for roadway
- Same section as Bay Settlement Road to the south
  - 11-foot travel lanes
  - 4-foot bike lanes
  - Curb and gutter
  - No parking on road





#### Bay Settlement Road

- Storm sewer will require rock removal by either blasting or rock trenching (this will be determined by the contractor)
- Blaster will be required to offer structure survey to all structures along Bay Settlement Road prior to blasting
- Blasting will be monitored per state statues
- Sanitary Sewer and water laterals will be installed to vacant lots that could develop in the future (the Town is working with those property owners that this affects)
- Storm sewer laterals can be installed if requested by the property owner from the main to the right-of-way, owner required to connect from ROW to home (owner shall hook-up to lateral within a year)



#### Bay Settlement Road


- The road will be closed to through traffic
- During storm sewer construction and blasting you will not be able to get past where they are working
- After hours contractor will provide for one lane to pass working area
- There will be periods of time you will not be able to get into your driveway
- Mailboxes will be removed by the contractor and placed in your lawn It will be property owner's responsibility to re-install mailboxes after
- construction is completed
- Temporary mailboxes will be set up on the south end of Bay Settlement Road just south of the construction limits



### Van Lanen Road

- about 0.5 -1 foot
- New base course and pavement will be added
- 11-foot driving lanes
- 3-foot paved shoulders
- Driveway culverts will not be replaced
- Two cross culverts will be replaced

#### Existing pavement and base will be removed and the road lowered



#### Van Lanen Road

- No blasting on this section of the project
- Roadway will be closed to through traffic
- point

- Lanen Road residents

During culvert replacements you will not be able to get through that

Mailboxes will be removed by the contractor and placed in your lawn It will be property owner's responsibility to re-install mailboxes Temporary mailboxes will be set up on Bay Heights Drive for Van

Driveways will be cut back 6-10 feet to match in with new roadway. The section cut out will be replaced with asphalt pavement



#### Project Schedule

- October 1, 2021
- with the contractor and residents to discuss the project
- Updates of project will be posted on the Town web site

Project is expected to start in May or June and completed by

Bay Settlement Road will begin first with Van Lanen being done later in the summer (this may change depending on contractor)

Once a contractor is awarded the project there will be a meeting
